## MOTION TO DISMISS PER AFFIDAVIT

COMES NOW the AIG Insurers (as listed on Exhibit A) and move this Court to dismiss them from the above-entitled action. Over 90 days have expired since the affidavits were filed and over six months has transpired since AIG Insurers submitted their answers to petitioner's discovery requests. (See attached Exhibit B – *Notice of Service of Discovery* dated 06/24/2014, Docket #718).

Early in these common fund proceedings the Court established an affidavit process for those insurers seeking dismissal. On December 6, 2005, the Court issued a memo describing the dismissal process. The memo stated as follows:

Attached is a blank form affidavit. If any insurer, self-insured, or guaranty association believes it should be dismissed from any of

the common fund matters you are directed to complete the affidavit and return it to the Workers' Compensation Court. If none of the enumerated reasons apply, you must prepare a separate affidavit for the Court's review.

Memo From Court to Counsel and All Parties With Blank Affidavit Form, 12/6/05 (Flynn Docket # 390). The attached affidavit required insurer's to check an appropriate box corresponding to various reasons for dismissal. The attached affidavit also required the insurer's to agree to a 90 day discovery period during which common fund counsel would be permitted to conduct discovery to determine the truth and accuracy of the statements made in the affidavit. Specifically, the affidavit stated as follows:

I understand that the Montana Workers' Compensation Court may allow a period of up to 90 days from the date of filing of this affidavit within which counsel for Petitioner[s] may conduct discovery and investigation for the limited purpose of proving or disproving the foregoing statement(s) made by me on behalf of

(NAME OF INSURER OR SELF INSURER). After such 90 days, if no objection is lodged by counsel for Petitioner[s], the Court will dismiss the insurer/self-insurer from this action based on the sworn statements made by

me in this affidavit.

Following a thorough review of their claim files, AIG insurers filed an affidavit on February 18, 2014. See McNeilly Affidavit, 2/12/14 (Flynn Docket # 714). The affidavit identified two, and only two, beneficiaries of the Flynn decision, advised that they had been paid their Flynn benefits (one-half their attorneys fees incurred in obtaining SSDI benefits), and that the appropriate amount had been withheld for satisfaction of Flynn's counsel's common fund attorneys' fee lien. The affidavit further advised that AIG insurers were prepared to remit the attorney fee lien to Flynn's counsel as the Court should direct.

Following the filing of this affidavit, Flynn's counsel served discovery upon AIG Insurers as contemplated by the affidavit process. <u>See</u> *Notice of Service of Discovery*, 4/9/14 (*Flynn* Docket # 715).

AIG Insurers promptly responded to Flynn's discovery requests. <u>See Notice of Service of Discovery</u>, 6/20/14 (Flynn Docket # 718).<sup>1</sup>

Since that time Flynn's counsel has not objected to the AIG Insurer's dismissal. Nor has he communicated with counsel for AIG Insurers in any manner regarding this

case. Accordingly, as no objection to dismissal has been filed, and pursuant to the express terms of the Court's blank form affidavit, AIG Insurers must be dismissed from this action.
