It is my understanding, from discussions with Tom Budewitz, the attorney representing claimant on *Asarco, Inc. v. Foster*, WCC No. 2004-1120, that that case has resolved. Since the case has resolved, I do not believe there is any issue pertaining to the rate to be utilized in the application of the Rausch, Fisch, Frost decision of the Montana Supreme Court. I believe all parties are in agreement that the PPD rate that has been utilized in the past should be utilized concerning the Plan I and Plan II insurers.

In the event that the *Foster* matter has resolved, we would assume that there is no reason to delay any of the payment issues involving Rausch, et al., common fund litigation. We would appreciate some judicial confirmation as to the status of the *Asarco, Inc. v. Foster* claim, and whether the April 1 conference is to take place if there is a confirmation of settlement.
