This settlement stipulation is made and entered into by and between Lon J. Dale, Monte D. Beck and Stephen D. Roberts ("common fund attorneys") and Norman H. Grosfield, attorney for Montana Association of Counties' Workers' Compensation Trust (MACO WCTr).

Rather than the maximum fee allowed by statute, the Common Fund 1.

Attorneys have agreed to the same fee schedule approved by this Court in its July 10, 2003 Attorney Fee Order and Judgment in Rausch v. Montana State Fund, which is a fee of 15% of any impairment award paid to a claimant less than 60 years of age, 10% if the claimant is age 60 or 61, at 5% if the claimant is age 62 or 63. The ages are determined as of the date of the Supreme Court decision in Rausch, September 5, 2002.

Fees have been withheld by MACOWCTr from the impairment awards of the following individuals as set forth below:

- 2. The common fund attorneys agree to waive all attorneys' fees withheld beyond the percentage dictated by this Court's July 10, 2003 Attorney Fee Order and set forth above. Therefore, the amount in the "Balance Due Claimant" column is to be refunded to the respective claimants by MACoWCTr.
- 3. Lon J. Dale hereby agrees to serve notice by certified mail to each claimant identified above of the attorneys' fees claimed from the attorneys' fees withheld. The notification shall be mailed to each claimant's address as provided by MACOWCTr. Each claimant will be given three weeks from the time of mailing within which to object. In the event of an objection, claimants shall be required to file their written objections with the Workers' Compensation Court or Mr. Grosfield, or with Mildragovich, Dale, Steinbrenner & Nygren, P.C. Further, Lon J. Dale shall advise the Court by affidavit at the conclusion of the three weeks, confirming notice to claimants and status of any objections. Should objections be made, this Court will schedule a hearing to hear the objections and after the hearing, issue an order regarding the payment of the common fund attorneys' fees. If there are no objections, a request will

be made for an appropriate court order from the Workers' Compensation Court ordering MACOWCTr, through its attorney, to pay the stated common fund fees and reimburse the claimant's the balances due. MACOWCTr shall promptly thereafter send a check in the amount of \$12,666.76 payable to Milodragovich, Dale, Steinbrenner & Nygren, P.C. Trust Account (MDSN Trust Account) for equal distribution to the common fund attorneys, and distribute to the respective claimants the amounts set forth in the "Balance Due Claimants" column of this stipulation.
