COMES NOW, Hortica Insurance f/k/a Florists' Mutual Insurance Company (Florists'), and moves the Court to dismiss Florists' from the above action.

On or about April 22, 2005, this Court had served on many insurers, including Florists' Mutual, a Summons and Notice of Attorney Lien requiring each of the insurers to respond to the attorney fee lien filed by Petitioners' attorneys. The Summons required that each insurer consider which claimants' benefits have been limited as a resultof the age-related limits in § 39-71-701, MCA. The Court also ordered all insurers to withhold twenty-five percent of additional benefits paid after December 22, 2004, on account of the *Reesor* decision to claimants who were injured on or after July 1, 1987, and prior to December 22, 2004.

On June 6, 2005, Florists' filed a Response to Petitioner's Request for Certification of a Common Fund and Enforcement of Attorney Lien. In that response, Florists' contended that it had no potential liability with regard to the *Reesor* claims.

Florists' Mutual has had the opportunity to complete a full review of its Montana claims files to determine what claimants may have been affected by the age-related

limits under § 39-71-710, MCA. The conclusion of Florists' is that there are no cases where Florists' Mutual Insurance Company limited claimants' workers' compensation permanent partial disability benefits as a result of those claimants' reaching the age of 65. This conclusion is supported by the attached Affidavit of Brent Bates, Senior Vice President - Director of Claims and Corporate Secretary/Counsel for Hortica Insurance Company, f/k/a/ Florists' Mutual Insurance Co. (Exhibit 1).

WHEREFORE, Florists' moves this Court to dismiss with prejudice Florists' Mutual Insurance Company on the ground that no claims exist against Florists' and that Florists' is not liable for any additional benefits to be paid to claimants in this matter and Florists' is not obligated to withhold twenty-five percent on any claims for attorneys' fees.
