Dear Mr. Feeback:

I was confused by your recent filing of an Affidavit in the above-entitled matter, as I had you previously responding to the Summons by pleading dated February 24, 2006. In that pleading, you do not submit an affidavit from the insurer identifying a basis for dismissal from this lawsuit, but instead filed a substantive response to the claim for common fund attorney fees.

Despite your prior substantive response to the Summons, I would consider dismissing your client if you were to provide me with the following information:

- 1. Please describe the procedure used to determine Teck Cominco American Inc. "has no claimants meeting the Court's criteria as set forth in the Summons."
- 2. Please indicate the total number of occupational disease claims that Teck Cominco American Inc., had in Montana occurring on or after July 1, 1987.
- 3. Please indicate how many of the claims identified in response to question no. 2 involved the payment of temporary total disability benefits.

If I do not receive substantive answers to the foregoing questions within the 90 days permitted in paragraph 5 of the Summons, then I will advise the Court that I object to the dismissal of your client from this litigation.

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Thank you for your anticipated cooperation in responding to this correspondence.
