- 10 Insurance and Montana State Fund, intervenor. This

- 12 regarding the common fund fees entitled to common
- 13 fund counsel as pertains to State Fund claimants.

- 18 exception being noted, since there have been no
- 19 other objections, the -- what had been -- the
- 20 claimants had been notified that the proposed fee
- 21 was 25, would be 25 percent. State Fund does not
- 22 object to that. In light of, certainly, the long
- 23 history that Schmill has taken, I think that's an
- 24 appropriate fee. So I will approve the 25 percent
- 25 common fund fee and we will issue an order to that
