Dear Judge Shea:

As you know, the State Fund is disregarding the Stavenjord Common Fund and attorney fee lien, because it is sending out letters directly to hundreds of potential Stavenjord claimants. I received a copy of Tom Martello's 4/18/08 letter to the Court, which included a "representative Stavenjord letter." Mr. Martello's letter asks potential Stavenjord claimants a number of legal questions, which should first be discussed with their own counsel before they are answered. Unfortunately, Mr. Martello's 4/18/08 letter implies to the Court that the "representative Stavenjord letter" is the only one being sent, but that is not the case. Here, I attach a 4/14/08 letter that the State Fund sent to Attorney Luke Faust incorrectly informing his Stavenjord client that there is a "final decision."

Stavenjord argues that it will be "impractical or impossible" to supervise the payment of Stavenjord-type benefits without common fund counsel. Therefore, Stavenjord asks this Court to uphold the attorney fee lien until the Montana Supreme Court conclusively rules on that issue in Stavenjord III. In the meantime, the State Fund should not be allowed to disregard the Stavenjord Common Fund and attorney fee lien.
