Dear Judge McCarter:

I am in receipt of Tom Murphy's letter to you of November 11, 2003. I do not agree with his statements that he attributed to me or to the practices of Liberty.

As regards settlement of cases possibly impacted by Stavenjord and/or Schmill, I recently settled a case, with Jay Dufrechou, Hearing Examiner, in which the claimant acknowledged the existence of those cases in a decision to settle before the final resolution. The parties sent in a stipulation for entry of judgment in that case. Sutich v. Liberty Northwest Ins. Corp., WCC No. 2003-0765.

Tom's letter raises an issue that I have not heard discussed at the hearings you have held. Specifically, Tom may be claiming that cases impacted by Stavenjord and/or Schmill cannot be settled, if they are settled, that there has to be some type of carve out provision in the settlement covering the contingency of common fund attorney fees.
