LIBERTY'S BRIEF IN OPPOSITION TO DISCOVERY

Satterlee has filed her Motion and Brief for an Order Allowing Discovery which Liberty opposes.

This Court in its ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION in the instant case at paragraph 9 held as follows: "The fundamental crux of the Court's opinion denying the Petitioners' Motion for Summary Judgment was not grounded in the **degree** of financial impact to the workers' compensation system a finding of unconstitutionality may bring. Rather, the Court's determination that a rational basis exists for terminating PTD benefits upon a claimant's eligibility for social security or a comparable retirement system is primarily grounded in a finding that such a statutory scheme is rationally related to insuring that PTD benefits: (1) compensate an injured worker for his or her 'work life'; and (2) do not become the 'pension program' the legislature specifically intended **not** to create in enacting §39-71-710 MCA." (emphasis in the original)

Although the Court considered the financial impact in reaching its decision, that impact has nothing to do with the rational basis test on which the Court relied. Therefore allowing the discovery Satterlee is requesting will not affect the "the fundamental crux of the Court's opinion.

Therefore, Satterlee's Motion should be denied in this matter certified for appeal.
