II 1 While Respondent disagrees with the outcome of this case, on February 6, 2007, counsel for Petitioner and Respondent jointly informed the Court that they agree that the $\$ 177.07$ figure which the Court used as the average weekly wage for Petitioner's employment with Priorcare ${ }^{1}$ is incorrect, and that the correct average weekly wage for Petitioner's employment with Priorcare is $\$ 192.19$. This makes the aggregate of average actual wages of all Petitioner's employments $\$ 492.82,{ }^{2}$ rather than $\$ 477.70$ as this Court noted in $\mathbb{T} 32$ of the Decision.

II 2 THEREFORE, the weekly rate for TTD benefits that Petitioner is entitled to receive is $\$ 328.56 .^{3}$
